Contestants must have a valid Louisiana fishing license or permit unless except by state law. Participants 16 or under must be accompanied by an adult or guardian. Any person that has been disqualified from any prior fishing tournament may not be allowed to enter this event. No alcoholic beverages consumed during tournament hours.

Entry Fee/Awards/Mail-ins

Entry fee \$100 per team with an Optional Big Bass Division. Awards based on five (5) bass limit. Only one (1) bass per team will count in the Big Bass Division. Mail-is must be post marked on or before Monday, February 1, 2021. Mail to: Robby Roberts, 114

Jackson Court, Vidalia, LA 71373. There will be a \$10 late fee if you enter on tournament morning at the State Park. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse any entry fee.

Launch Sites/Casing Time/Weigh In

Launch anywhere on Lake Bruin. Start casting at 6:30 a.m. Stop casting and be off plane at the STATE PARK BEFORE 3:00 P.M. Make sure your boat's NAVIGATION LIGHTS ARE ON if boating before daylight. Be Careful! MUST BE IN WEIGH IN LINE BY 3:30 PM.

Off-Limits/Official Times/Creel Limit/Length Requirement/Dead Fish Penalty

Lake Bruin will be off-limits to fishing beginning on MONDAY, Feb. 1, 2021 until FRIDAY, Feb. 5, 2021. Launch any time after 4:00 A.M. from any landing, go to your area and start casting at 6:30 a.m. Cell phone/GPS time or ask the tournament director for the official time. You must be in the weight-in area "off plane" no later than 3:00 P.M. A one (1) pound penalty will be deducted per minute after 3:00 p.m. from your total weight. Each team may weigh-in their five (5) largest bass with a minimum length of 12 inches. Only one bass per team will count in the big bass division. All bass must be caught on artificial lures on rods 8 feet or shorter. Trolling is prohibited. Official measuring board: Golden Rule. No bass on ice will be weighed. To insure a good "live" release, please keep your fish in your livewell until the weigh-in line thins out. A .20 pounds per dead bass will be deducted from total weight. Only the team that caught the fish are allowed to present them to the weigh-master. If you experience a mechanical problem: one or both team members may board another contestant's boat and bring their catch to the scales. In case of a tie, the team with the single largest bass wins. Any further ties will be broken by a sudden death fish-off or split 1st and 2nd place winnings. Any artificially weighted bases will not be weighed and the contestant will be subject to prosecution under federal and state law. A metal detector may be used at the weigh in. Any questionable bass will be subject to internal inspection by the tournament director. Trailering bass to the weigh-in site is not allowed. Anyone caught cheating will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law and the cheaters name will be made public. Any protest must be presented in writing to the Tournament Director by 3:45 p.m. on 02-06-2021.

$\underline{Safety/Outboard\ Horsepower\ Regulations/Sportsmanship}$

All contestants must obey Federal, state and Local Laws. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. You must have your running lights on during takeoff. Good Sportsmanship, Courtesy, Safety and Conservation is expected from all contestants. Please run at safe speeds and stay in the middle of the lake when running at wide-open throttle. All boats must be equipped with an emergency ignition cutoff device and lanyard must be attached to driver when outboard is in use. U.S. Coast Guard approved life jacket must be on and secured when the outboard is in use.
